Action Item 3

Alice Howe (AH) advised that the contamination map shown in the presentation pre-dated closure of Pasminco and detailed contamination testing. Council's Contamination Database is based on more recent and more accurate testing either conducted by Ferrier Hodgson as part of the LAS, or subsequent testing generally for development assessment. Where site-specific testing was not undertaken, land has notation 1, which indicates actual or potential contamination.

Agenda Item 5 – Pasminco Pollution Concerns

The recent Pasminco pollution incident was discussed. RB provided a briefing on the works that have been carried out to date on the Pasminco and Tripad sites. Groundwater issues and testing were discussed in detail including zinc and cadmium levels in the basin.

Adam Gilligan (AG) provided advice regarding the milky plume and advised that the EPA is also continuing to investigate an incident on 19 November 2015 where a quantity of milky water was observed discharging from the Pasminco site. The results of sampling from that incident showed heavy metal levels in discharge did not present a concern for human health however the short and long term environmental impacts will form part of the EPA's ongoing investigations. Graphs presented by AG on the metal concentrations will be provided to the CRG.
