landfills service Greater Sydney's household waste



Greater Sydney's landfill space is expected to run out by

2030,

potentially increasing household waste management costs

Recycling rates have stalled at around **65**% since 2015–16



65%

falling short of the **80**% resource recovery target set by 2030





By 2050, it's expected there will be more plastic than fish in the ocean by weight



NSW aims to triple plastic recycling by 2030,

reduce all litter by **60**% by 2030, and cut plastic litter by **30**% by 2025



Over the last decade, the NSW Environment Protection Authority has awarded more than

\$500 million in grants to 960+ organisations, supporting 3,300+ projects

In 2022–23, NSW generated

22.4

million tonnes of waste,

recycling **14.7 million tonnes** while sending **7.7 million tonnes** of potentially recoverable material to landfill

In 2022–23, aproximately

891,000 tonnes of plastic waste was produced

and around

of this was recycled

This has resulted in diversion of more than 4 million tonnes of waste from landfill
