

Important Notice to Community: Operations Winding Down at Riverstone Plant - NSW

A J Bush & Sons (Manufactures) Pty Ltd regrets to announce that we are taking the difficult decision to wind down operations at our Riverstone NSW site.

Head of Rendering at the plant's operating company Bush's Proteins, Cameron Bush, said a build-up of residential development and the planned Stage 3 release of land in the area for more housing made it impossible to remain.

"It's a difficult decision as our plant has been a part of the Riverstone community since the 1950s, but Riverstone is no longer a semi-rural fringe suburb. All our existing community sponsorships will be honoured," said Cameron Bush.

All collection/receival, aggregation and processing will cease by the end of May and the site's processing equipment will be decommissioned and removed. Bush's Proteins will continue to work with the Environmental Protection Agency to responsibly manage its exit.

We appreciate your understanding and support during this winding down process. We will keep you informed of our progress and look forward to continuing our relationship with the Riverstone community.
