- FORESTS ARE VITAL FOR CLIMATE STABILISATION
- THERE ARE NATURAL LIMITATIONS IN SUPPLY TO MEET THE DEMAND
- PLUNGING OLD GROWTH FOREST HAS INCREASED ENDANGERED COMMUNITIES OF FLORA + FAUNA
- THE ECONOMIC LOSSES ARE NO LONGER SUSTAINABLE, DRAINING SOILS + WATER COURSE.
